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OASIS Program Overview

What is OASIS?

One Acquisition Solution for Integrated Services (OASIS) is a General Services Administration (GSA) issued, awarded, and managed Multi-Agency Contract vehicle (MAC) that provides clients across the Federal Government with easy access to complex professional services requirements. The OASIS program gives Federal agencies access to pre-qualified awardees of two separate contracts: OASIS Unrestricted, and OASIS Small Business (SB). GSA awarded Deloitte the OASIS Unrestricted contract for Pool 1 (Engineering and Consulting Services) and Pool 2 (Financial Services) in September 2014. GSA awarded Deloitte the OASIS Unrestricted contract for Pool 3 (Military/ Marine/ Energy Engineering Services) and Pool 4 (Scientific Research and Development (R&D) Services) in September 2020.

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

Capability: ML-Powered Misinformation Analysis

As the COVID-19 pandemic and interrelated infodemic spread across the globe in early 2020, Novetta and Amazon Web Services (AWS) partnered to address the discord in social media analysis between accuracy and speed. The resulting capability, Rapid Narrative Analysis (RNA), facilitates both by leveraging human expertise at critical stages of analysis, while using state-of-the-art ML models to allow effective and swift response to address the spread of misinformation.




